The Starting Line

From tumor microenvironment and immune responses to nanoparticle therapeutics and drug discovery, Kansas State University faculty members are conducting basic and translational research that improves the understanding of cancer and leads to better ways of detecting, treating and preventing it.

Guided by its vision to take a leading role in conquering cancer in our time, the Johnson Cancer Research Center, in the College of Arts and Sciences, advances cancer research through competitive awards that spark innovation among faculty and inspire students to pursue and excel in science. It is also a resource for the public to learn about cancer and research.

Research

The Johnson Cancer Research Center attacks cancer from many angles. Nearly 90 researchers in 18 departments are conducting cutting-edge, multidisciplinary research aimed at better understanding cancer and developing early diagnostic tools, anticancer drugs, safer surgical technologies and other therapies.

The center's competitive awards process directs funding to the most promising research projects, state-of-the-art laboratory equipment and technical training. Faculty members have leveraged the center's seed grants to up to 25 times as much in national funding.

Education

As Johnson Cancer Research Center faculty members make discoveries, students are right there beside them, training to become the next generation of cancer scientists and medical professionals.

The center's Cancer Research Award program involves undergraduate students in faculty-mentored research and supports the summertime research endeavors of graduate students, the workhorses of the lab. Such experience is extremely beneficial to students pursuing advanced degrees and careers in science and medicine, which many awardees go on to do.

Travel awards also enable graduate students and postdoctoral fellows to present their work at professional meetings.

Outreach

The center hosts tours, gives presentations, and offers materials and events to inform the public about cancer, risk reduction and research. Among its resources are the pamphlet "When a Friend Has Cancer," created by local cancer survivors and nurses, and the children's activity book, "A Day With Dr. Waddle," in which cancer is explained in a kid-friendly way by a scientist who happens to be a duck.
